Crime and Safety

Officers continue to be very proactive in keeping Hermosa safe. Here are some highlights from 2022:

- Bike Smart Hermosa" safety campaign was launched to increase bicycle safety awareness.
- Removal of guns off the street was increased due to proactive traffic stops.
 Other weapons recovered include knives, tear gas, switch blades, hammers, a machete, and stun guns.
- Over 4,000 traffic stops were conducted by officers, including targeted enforcement of unsafe bicyclists and loud exhaust from vehicles.

Technology

The Detective Bureau joined the Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force. The objective is to combat increasing online activity by predators seeking contact with potential underage victims.





Additional grant funds were awarded by the State Homeland Security Program; will support updates to camera equipment, including the purchase of new cameras and updating older models.

The Bait Bike Program was designed to decrease bicycle thefts. As a result, the program recorded **37 arrests.** 31 of these arrests resulted in felony filings of career criminals and many received prison sentences.
