459PC BURGLARY Between 10/07/17 @ 1930 – 10/08/17 @ 1400 300 BLK MONTEREY

Unknown suspect gained access to victim's vehicle by unknown means and took items from inside.

Arrestee did not return his mother's vehicle on the date they agreed upon.
