Unknown suspect(s) gain access into victim's locked vehicle by unknown means and remove items from inside.

The unknown suspect entered two business and tried to get change for a counterfeit \$100 bill. The businesses refused to exchange the money and the suspect fled in a vehicle.

An unknown suspect forged two checks belonging to the victim and cashed them.

An unlocked vehicle was entered, pocket knife and cash were stolen.
