Beginning March 1, a new city ordinance will establish smoke-free zones in the following locations:

- Pier Plaza
- The Pier
- The Strand
- The Greenbelt
- All public parking lots
- Public parks
- The Beach
- Outdoor dining areas, including within five feet of outdoor dining areas
