CONTRACTOR LICENSE DESCRIPTIONS AND REQUIREMENTS

A – General Engineering Contractor

Business & Professions Code

Division 3, Chapter 9, Contractors, Article 4, Classifications

7056. A general engineering contractor is a contractor whose principal contracting business is in connection with fixed works requiring works requiring specialized engineering knowledge and skill, including the following divisions or subjects: irrigation, drainage, water power, water supply, flood control, inland waterways, harbors, docks and wharves, shipyards and ports, dams and hydroelectric projects, levees, river control and reclamation works, railroads, highways, streets and roads, tunnels, airports and airways, sewers and sewage disposal plans and systems, waste reduction plans, bridges, overpasses, underpasses and other similar works, pipelines and other systems for the transmission of petroleum and other liquid or gaseous substances, parks, playgrounds and other utility plans and installations, mines and metallurgical plans, land leveling and earthmoving projects, excavating, grading, trenching, paving and surfacing work and cement and concrete works in connection with the above mentioned fixed works.

C-8 – Concrete Contractor

California Code of Regulations

Title 16, Division 8, Article 3, Classifications

A concrete contractor forms, pours, places, finishes and installs specified mass, pavement, flat and other concrete work; and places and sets screens for pavements or flatwork. This class shall not include contractors whose sole contracting business is the application of plaster coatings or the placing and erecting of steel or bars for the reinforcing of mass, pavement, flat and other concrete work.

C-12 – Earthwork and Paving Contractors

California Code of Regulations

Title 16, Division 8, Article 3, Classifications

An earthwork and paving contractor digs, moves, and places material forming the surface of the earth, other than water, in such a manner that a cut, fill excavation, grade,

trench, backfill, or tunnel (if incidental thereto) can be executed, including the use of explosives for these purposes. The classification includes the mixing, fabricating, and placing of pavement and any other surfacing materials.

C-34 – Pipeline Contractor
California Code of Regulations
Title 16, Division 8, Article 3, Classifications

A pipeline contractor fabricates and installs pipelines for the conveyance of fluids, such as water, gas, or petroleum, or the containment or protection of any other materials, including the application of protective coatings or systems and the trenching, boring, shoring, backfilling, compacting, paving and surfacing necessary to complete the installation of such pipelines.
