



SB205 STORMWATER DISCHARGE COMPLIANCE AND BUSINESS LICENSING

Dear Facility Operator, Landowner, or other Responsible Party,

California Senate Bill 205, approved on October 2, 2019, mandates certain facilities demonstrate coverage under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Industrial General Permit (IGP) program prior to being issued a new or renewed business license on and after January 1, 2020. A business requires IGP coverage if it has a regulated Standard Industrial Classification (SIC Code). Regulated SIC Codes are defined in Attachment A of the IGP:

Businesses requiring IGP coverage must comply via electronic submittal of applications and reporting to the Storm Water Multiple Application and Report Tracking System (SMARTS):

To meet the requirements of Senate Bill No. 205, businesses operating as a regulated facility within the City of Hermosa Beach must provide the following information, to the extent applicable, as part of the business licensing process:

- The name and location of facilities operated by that business.
- All primary SIC Codes for the business.
- Whichever of the following apply for each facility operated by that business, as issued by the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB):
 - The stormwater permit number, known as the Waste Discharger Identification number (WDID).
 - The WDID application number.
 - The “notice of non-applicability” (NONA) identification number.
 - The “no exposure certification” (NEC) identification number.
