### **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. Hours of operation: 9am-9pm daily, national holidays and certain City holidays excepted. The City reserves the right to post signage indicating closure on particular dates and at particular times.
2. The batting cages are for batting practice only. Batters should only occupy the batting cages while preparing to or actively batting.
3. No spectators are allowed in the batting cages.
4. Closed toe shoes must be worn while in the batting cages at all times.
5. When others are waiting to bat, batters must give up use of their cages at the end of one (1) hour of use. It is the responsibility of active batters to give up their cages after one (1) hour of use to any and all those waiting to bat.
6. Bat at your own risk. By entering the batting cages, you agree to waive any and all claims against the City of Hermosa Beach and its employees, including claims for injuries, including death, that you or another person may suffer as a result of your or another person's intentional or negligent conduct.
7. The Hermosa Beach Little League has exclusive use of the batting cages during their season, annually from March through July. The batting cages are closed to the general public from March 1 through July 31.
8. The public may not make use of any pitching machines while using the batting cages. This rule does not apply to the Hermosa Beach Little League.
9. Helmets must be worn at all times when using the batting cages, regardless of whether or not you are actively batting.
10. Never climb on or hang from the cage.
11. Swing the bat inside the cage only. Be aware of your surroundings. You alone are responsible for any injuries you or another person may suffer as a result of your use of the cage.
12. No food or drink is allowed in the batting cages, whether sealed or opened.
13. Smoking, vaping, drug and/or alcohol use is prohibited in the batting cages as well as anywhere in the Clark Complex.
14. All classes, instruction, and organized activity of any kind must be approved in advance and in writing by the City.
15. Pets or other animals are not permitted in the cages at any time.
