## **Dealing with Unsold Items**

#### 1. Give Away

• Hermosa has a thriving <u>Buy Nothing group</u> on Facebook.

#### 2. Donate to local charities

• Local charities (i.e., Goodwill, House of Yaweh, etc.) will accept items that are still usable, functional and in fair condition. This includes clothes, appliances, furniture and more.

#### 3. E-Waste / Hazardous Waste

 Electronics, chemicals, batteries, paints, oils and other household hazardous waste can be taken to the S.A.F.E. Center at the Hyperion Waste Treatment Plant in Playa del Rey.
