When signed by the Chief of Police, this permit authorizes a BLOCK PARTY subject to the following conditions:

1. The permittee shall provide written notice to all properties on the street to be blocked and each immediately adjacent street in every direction. The notice shall contain all of the information at the top of this permit; a copy of this permit will satisfy this requirement. The permittee shall attach a list of the properties, including the address, name(s) of the property owner(s) or resident(s), and their signature showing approval of the event. To meet the permit requirements, the permittee shall obtain a 2/3 majority approval from the owners or residents.
2. The block party must terminate at the ending time set forth above; all street barriers shall be removed from the intersections at that time and placed in a safe place.
3. The sound/music volume and the noise generated from the function shall be controlled so that it will not be unreasonably loud, disturbing, or a nuisance to persons living in nearby residences. If police officers determine that the volume of noise from the block party is unusually loud and disruptive to the surrounding neighborhood, upon direction from the senior police officer on the scene the permittee shall take immediate steps to reduce, control and maintain the noise at an acceptable level.
4. The permittee(s) shall insure that no minors consume any alcoholic beverage and shall not permit any alcoholic beverage to be consumed in public streets and sidewalks. Sale of alcoholic beverages is strictly prohibited.
5. If Police are called to the scene because the party is unduly disruptive or noisy or the number of attendees exceeds the estimate stated above, and permittees are unable or unwilling to control the problem, the senior on-duty officer may revoke this permit and cause the function to be terminated and the people present to disperse immediately. Additionally, the permittee may be cited for violations of HBMC 8.24.030 and 8.24.070, and subject to a fine and court costs.
6. The permittee(s) shall be on the premises at all times and shall immediately identify himself/herself to Police Officers
7. Permittee will be required to contact the Hermosa Beach Public Works Department at 310-318-0259 (Monday-Thursday 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.) who will provide the appropriate street barriers that are clearly visible to passing vehicles and that can readily be moved in case of an emergency for Police and Fire vehicles. It is also the responsibility of the permittee to remove the street barriers at the end of the event and return them to the City Public Works Department. After regular business hours, the Public Works Department can be reached by calling the non-emergency dispatch number, 310-524-2750.
8. Jumpers are allowed provided there remains a 15ft. wide access after placement for Police and Fire vehicles in case of an emergency.

I HAVE READ THE FOREGOING CONDITIONS, UNDERSTAND THEM AND ACCEPT THEM. I WILL CONDUCT THE BLOCK PARTY IN COMPLIANCE WITH THESE CONDITIONS. FAILURE TO DO SO MAY RESULT IN REVOCATION OF THIS PERMIT AND TERMINATION OF THE BLOCK PARTY.
