Potential Measures for Hermosa Beach **Public Safety & Emergency Preparedness**

Hermosa Beach is focusing on recruiting and retaining highly trained police officers to strengthen emergency response capabilities. The City could implement advanced technology and crime prevention programs, while enhancing security measures at schools, parks, and beaches. In addition, prioritizing fire safety, emergency preparedness, and traffic safety initiatives will help ensure a safer environment for both residents and visitors.



Parks, Facility Repairs, & Community **Beautification Initiatives**

Hermosa Beach is working to maintain safe, clean neighborhoods and public spaces, ensuring the upkeep of existing parks, beaches, and public facilities. This involves replacing outdated lighting, repairing leaking roofs, constructing and restoring restrooms, and making necessary repairs to community facilities. Efforts to beautify neighborhoods and business districts is also a priority.



Infrastructure & Capital Improvements

The City focuses on street maintenance, including pothole repairs and road resurfacing projects. Sidewalk repairs and replacements, traffic engineering enhancements, and facility parking lot improvements may also be considered, along with capital improvement projects targeting the aging infrastructure.



City Projects & Operational Priorities

Hermosa Beach continues to explore opportunities to support local business retention and investment, update the General Plan and Economic Development Strategic Plans, and improve technology and connectivity. Efforts to enhance signage and maintain clean, safe public spaces is part of ongoing City
