530.5PC **ID THEFT** Between 10/26/16 @ 0830 - 0900 400 BLK HERMOSA AVE

Credit card opened in victim's name without their permission.

484PC Between 10/28/16 @ 0630 - 1700 500 BLK MANHATTAN AV

Open garage of apartment building was entered, surfboard and wetsuit were stolen.

484(A)PC Between 10/29/16 @ 1600 - 2300 00 BLK PIER PZ

Bike locked to bike rack was stolen by unknown means.

594(A)PC VANDALISM Between 10/31/16 @ 2130 - 11/01/16 @ 0630 100 BLK HERMOSA AV

Unknown suspect walked on the hood of vehicle causing damage.

Victim was walking home and somewhere along the way lost their keys, DL, phone and credit cards.

Two left tires were punctured by unknown means. Possible suspect is known.

Victim was walking with suitcase when approached by 3 males who grabbed suitcase causing it to open and spill some contents.

Suspect rented residence for 3 months and turned around and rented the same residence out on Air B&B for a profit.

484PC THEFT 1100 BLK PACIFIC COAST HY Between 10/26/16 @ 2149 -2200

While the victim was filling his vehicle with gasoline, an unknown suspect opened the passenger side door and removed items from the vehicle.

10851(A)VC STOLEN VEHICLE Between 10/29/16 @ 0925 - 0935 1000 BLK PACIFIC COAST HY

Victim took car to the car was and an unknown suspect entered the vehicle, driving it away.
