Vehicle was entered by unknown means, ransacked and bag with jewelry stolen.

Motorcycle was stolen from the secured parking garage of an apartment complex.

An unknown suspect entered the business office of the store and removed the victim's wallet. The credit cards were used to make purchases. A suspect was seen on video surveillance.

A vehicle parked on the street had the driver side rear view mirror broken off.

Victim left bicycle unlocked outside of store and upon return it was stolen. An adult male was seen walking away with the bicycle.

A known suspect entered the office of a tow truck company and took keys and invoice not belonging to them.

A motorcycle was stolen from the driveway of the residence. The vehicle was located by HBPD on 2/18/17.

The victim's unlocked vehicles were entered and various items were stolen. Surveillance video shows a female suspect going through vehicles.

459PC *BURGLARY Between 02/17/17 @ 2230 – 02/18/17 @ 0830 1100 BLK 11TH ST

An unsecured attached garage was entered and 2 bicycles were stolen.

530.5PC ID THEFT 02/11/17 @ 1700 1200 BLK 8TH ST

Victim's identity was used to open a Cox Communication account.

484(A)PC *THEFT Between 02/16/17 @ 1900 - 02/17/17 @ 1830 1100 BLK 3RD ST

A vehicle was entered by unknown means and items were stolen.

Remember to HIDE IT, LOCK IT, KEEP IT. Always lock your vehicle doors and keep valuables out of sight. Leaving mail and

valuables in plain sight makes your vehicle a target for thieves, even when you park your vehicle in your own driveway, garage, or carport. Keep your homes and garages locked, even when you're at home. Bicycles should always be secured with a heavyduty lock and chained to a solid object that the bicycle cannot be lifted over. Lock frame first, then back wheel and front wheel.

<u>IF YOU SEE SOMETHING, SAY SOMETHING.</u> Report suspicious activity in your neighborhood by calling the non–emergency dispatch line at 310-524-2750, or 9-1-1 right away. See the attached examples for identifying suspicious activity but always

follow your instincts; if it doesn't look right, report it.



SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY- FOLLOW YOUR INSTINCTS!

One of the most important roles you have as a member of our community is to report suspicious activity.

What is suspicious activity? Anything that seems out of place or out of the ordinary in your neighborhood can be considered suspicious activity.

Examples of suspicious activity include, but are not limited to:

A person or vehicle stays in the same place for an unusual length of time.	A vehicle drives around your block frequently, slowing down, speeding up.
A parked car with the engine running- regardless of a person inside or not.	A vehicle without lights on, arriving or leaving at night.
A person behaves strangely or exhibits unusual movements, looks out of place, or is wandering aimlessly.	A person running from a home for no apparent reason, especially at night.
A person concealing an object, carrying a weapon or suspicious bag.	A person sells/conducts business out of their car, van, truck, or other vehicle.
A person looking into cars, moving from car to car, and/or tries door handles.	A person looking into windows of homes, or forcibly entering a car or home

Many activities can be considered suspicious, and there could be reasonable explanations for some suspicious activities. By thinking things through, being observant and using commonsense, you will be able to make good judgment about whether an activity is suspicious. Your role as a concerned citizen is to report whatever you think is wrong or suspicious.

REPORT SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY BY CALLING NON-EMERGENCY DISPATCH AT 310-524-2750 OR 9-1-1

Remain calm. Avoid taking any risks. Your safety is most important. Keep away from the crime scene to preserve evidence. Try to remember the following:

What happened?

Time and place?

Was anyone hurt?

Description of suspect(s)

Description of vehicle(s)

License plate number

Time and direction of travel

Additional details and circumstances
