Tips on Preventing Crime and Vandalism in Your Neighborhood

Good lighting discourages crime. The best place to secure your vehicle is in your locked garage, but if this is not an option, consider installing motion activated lights that illuminate your driveway. If you must park your vehicle on the street, try to find a location that is well-lit.

Keep landscaping trimmed to eliminate hiding places and areas where criminals can dodge passing cars or police. Well-trimmed landscaping that's designed to work with your lighting makes your home less attractive to criminals.

Know your neighbors—become a HBPD Neighborhood Watch Block Captain. Being familiar with your neighbors helps to determine who should be around their home and who should not. HBPD Neighborhood Watch is about neighbors looking out for neighbors. Criminals will be the first to admit that nosy neighbors are a big deterrent.
