A subject broke the rear window of a vehicle. The subject then broke a window of a residence and fled on foot. Subject was located and arrested.

An unlocked bicycle was stolen and the victim watched the suspect ride off on it. Victim gave chase and did not locate the suspect.

AREA 3

An unknown subject forcibly entered the front door of the business, ransacked and stole \$40.

The victim's vehicle was parked without the top on, vehicle was entered, ransacked and backpack containing a computer were stolen.

The Hermosa Beach Police Department reminds residents never to leave keys inside a vehicle. There has been an uptick in vehicle thefts and opportunistic thieves are on the lookout for unlocked vehicles, or those with windows down. Keeping your spare or valet key in plain sight makes your vehicle an easy target, and opened windows invite thieves to enter your vehicle and gain access to items you may have thought were carefully hidden.

Remember to report suspicious activity. For example, if you see someone checking door handles or looking into vehicles, report this immediately by calling the non-emergency dispatch line at 310-524-2750 for a police response.
